## **DESCRIPTION**

The work of plasterers includes exterior stucco, exterior EIF's system, interior conventional plaster, interior veneer and all phases of ornamental plaster, scagliola, marblecrete and fireproofing.

## **APPRENTICESHIP PROCESS**

Apprentices must complete 7,000 hours of on-the-job training and 108 hours per year in the classroom. The plasterers' apprenticeship program requires a high school diploma or GED.
