Oregon Tradeswomen is offering our **Trades & Apprenticeship Career Class (TACC)** in Redmond. TACC is a free, Bureau of Labor and Industries state-certified, pre-apprenticeship training program for self-identified women interested in pursuing a career in the construction trades.



Skilled trades jobs start at **\$15-\$27** an hour and can go up to **\$25-\$87** an hour for journeyworkers and include excellent benefits such as healthcare, pension, training, and education.

- Career exploration in the construction trades
- Classroom learning and hands-on training
- Fitness conditioning
- Registered apprenticeship and employment placement support
